 - They very much appreciate our donation (from dance party, a little over \$700)
 - Nikki is the Director of philanthropy for WNC, she reaches out to donors in our region
 - There are 14 health centers in PP South Atlantic, since the 1980's PP's have consolidated. Our local PP opened as a education center in the 1970's...Now across from BOE on Mcdowell and have expanded services by 150%, the only abortion provider in WNC, and they are a destination for transgender health services.
 - Private donations are about 40% of their budget, and they also accept insurance, including medicaid.
 - They get Title X funding for "family planning" services rendered. Unfortunately, those funds are under attack.
 - Non-partisan political monies: GOTV, etc.
